Domaine Grand Nicolet is the oldest Rastellain winery, founded in 1926 by Joseph Nicolet.


The vineyard covers 23 hectares, spread over several terroirs. It is this complexity and richness that is used to produce the different cuvées.

Nose: Aromas of wild red fruit
Mouth: Well-balanced and tasty
